They need accurate information on pregnancy and their options. They also need to know what kind of help is available to them including, financial, educational, medical, and housing. They need someone to listen and care.

We Care is a ministry of compassion.

We offer:

- *Free & confidential pregnancy tests.
- *Education on pregnancy options.
- *Free, limited ultrasound for qualifying clients.
- *Assistance in finding medical and legal help.
- *Referrals for adoption
- *Earn While You Learn pregnancy and parenting education program providing maternity & infant clothing, equipment, and other needs.
- *On-going friendship and support.
- *Help to women and men experiencing emotional pain after an abortion.
- *Abstinence programs for teen groups.

Meet one on one with women or men

parenting skills 2–4 half days or
evenings a month.
- 3. Nurse Sonographer**
Be trained to perform Limited
Ultrasound 2–4 half days or evenings
a month.
- 4. Nurse**
Perform pregnancy tests 2–4 half
days or evenings a month.
- 5. Receptionist**
Answer phone and greet clients at
We Care 2–4 half days or evenings a
month.
- 6. Male Mentor**
Meet with partners who come into
We Care.
